The Tribal Transportation Program Coordinating Committee is the regulatory committee (25 CFR 170.155) established by federal regulations, to provide input and recommendations to the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) concerning the Tribal Transportation Program as detailed in Title 23 U.S.C. 202. The committee is made up of 12 primary and 12 alternate members appointed by the Secretary of the Interior.
